#### **ACT Anaheim awarding nearly \$1 million in grants**

ACT Anaheim recently announced nearly \$1 million in grants to organizations serving Anaheim youth.

Formed in 2013, ACT (Accelerate Change Together) Anaheim is a collaboration among the Disneyland Resort, Angels Baseball and the Anaheim Ducks that focuses on helping those ages 13-18.

Receiving grants this year are 12 groups ranging from youth clubs to arts programs to mental health service providers. They are sharing \$982,500.

The largest grants of \$120,000 are going to the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Orange County, Girls Inc., Taller San Jose Hope Builders and Western Youth Services.

Since the first grants were awarded in 2014, the collaborative said it has given out nearly \$6 million.
